Christian Camp Scholarship Program

Document of Intentions

Dear Camper & Parent:

Once again, LCC is offering scholarships as an encouragement for youth to attend an approved Christian Summer Camp. This “first-come-first-served” scholarship program applies to regular attenders of LCC youth ministries for whom cost is an obstacle to attending summer camp. The scholarships are provided directly to the camps and cover up to \$250 or half of the cost of tuition –which ever is the lower amount. The following Camps are approved: Camp Cedarbrook, Delta Lake Bible Camps, Camp Pattersonville, Camp Pinnacle, Camp of the Woods, Deerfoot Lodge, Baptist Bible College Defender Sports Camp, Good Tidings Bible Conference, Northern Frontier, Peniel Bible Conference, Sacandaga Bible Conference, Tapawingo, and Word of Life.

Requirements - The youth applying for a scholarship must complete each of the corresponding requirements for attendance, service, and Scripture memorization by May 31.

1. **Attendance** - The youth must attend at least 70% of the meetings between October 1 and May 31 in one LCC ministry.
2. **Service** - One of the following service requirements must be met:
 - a. Grades K-2: Five hours of service at home approved and verified in writing by parent.
 - b. Grades 3-6: Five hours of service (verified in writing by parent) in one of the following:
 - i. service at home beyond normal chores, not including cleaning their own room;
 - ii. Nursing Home Ministry (must accompanied by parent);
 - iii. Helps Ministry (must accompanied by parent);
 - iv. Other LCC special service project (must be approved by Ministry Leader).
 - c. Grades 7-12: Five hours of service verified by parent or Ministry Leader in:
 - i. Common Ground’s Compassion in Action
 - ii. Children’s Church
 - iii. Nursery
 - iv. Helps Ministry (must accompanied by parent);
 - v. Other LCC special service project (must be approved by Ministry Leader).
3. **Scripture Memory** - Acceptable versions include NIV, NAS, or KJV. It is not necessary to recite all verses in one session.
 - a. Grades K-1: The books of the New Testament, in order.
 - b. Grade 2: The books of the Bible, in order.
 - c. Grade 3: Grade 2 requirements plus Matthew 22:36-40.
 - d. Grade 4: Grade 3 requirements plus Philippians 4:6-7
 - e. Grades 5-6: Grade 4 requirements plus Romans 1:16 and 2 Corinthians 5:17.
 - f. Grades 7-8: Grade 6 requirements plus Matthew 18:20 and 2 Timothy 3:16.
 - g. Grades 9-12: Grade 8 requirements plus Romans 3:23, 5:8, 6:23, 10:9, 10:13, 12:1,2.
